CRIMINAL SYNDICALISM ACT REPEALED.

AN ACT providing for the repeal of chapter 174, Session Laws of 1919 of [the State of] Washington relating to criminal syndicalism.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That chapter 174 of the Session Laws of 1919 of [the State of] Washington, (sections 2563-1 and 2563-2 of Remington's Revised Statutes of Washington and Pierce's Code, sections 9127-1 and 9127-2) relating to criminal syndicalism, be and the same is hereby repealed. Repeals
