

CHAPTER 39.

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION—SECRETARY OF STATE.
 AN ACT making a deficiency appropriation for the office of
 Secretary of State, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of
 Washington:*

SECTION 1. By reason of a deficiency existing in
 the appropriations made by the Twenty-ninth Legis-
 lature, the following sums, or so much thereof as
 shall be found necessary, are hereby appropriated
 out of any moneys in the General Fund of the State
 Treasury, for the fiscal biennium beginning April 1,
 1945, and ending March 31, 1947:

Salaries and wages.....	\$1,342.60
Printing Initiative and Referendum pamphlets	7,414.76
Total.....	<u>\$8,757.36</u>

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate
 support of the state government and its existing
 public institutions and shall take effect immediately.
