PORT DISTRICTS—REVISION OF COMMISSIONER DISTRICTS.

AN ACT relating to port districts; and amending sections 1 and 2, chapter 145, Laws of 1933 and RCW 53.16.010.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Sections 1 and 2, chapter 145, Laws of 1933 (heretofore combined and codified as RCW 53.16.010) are each amended to read as set forth in section 2 of this act.

Combination and amendment.

SEC. 2. (RCW 53.16.010) Within ninety days preceding July 1st of each even-numbered year, the port commissions may, and upon petition signed by not less than two hundred and fifty electors residing in the district shall, reestablish the boundaries of the commissioner districts in the port district, so that each commissioner district shall comprise as nearly as possible one-third of the population of the port district: *Provided*, That no voting precinct shall be divided by the boundary lines of a commissioner district.
