

CHAPTER 14.

RELIEF OF STEWART E. SMITH.

AN ACT for the relief of Stewart E. Smith, King county, State of Washington, and making appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the sum of one hundred and ninety-seven dollars (\$197.) be, and is hereby appropriated out of the state treasury, from any funds not otherwise appropriated, to pay Stewart E. Smith for his services in completing the House Journal of 1909 after the adjournment thereof. Appropriating \$197.00.

SEC. 2. The state auditor is hereby authorized to draw a warrant on the state treasurer for the said sum in favor of Stewart E. Smith, and the said treasurer is hereby directed to pay said warrant out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated. Auditor draw warrant.

CHAPTER 15.

RELIEF OF MARY A. BRADLEY ET AL.

AN ACT for the relief of Mary A. Bradley, William O. Bradley, Janie Bradley and Florence Bradley, of Spokane county, and making an appropriation therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred eighteen and fifty-nine hundredths dollars (\$318.59) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the relief of Mary A. Bradley, William O. Bradley, Janie Bradley and Appropriating \$318.59.
