

CHAPTER 47.

OYSTER LANDS AND OYSTER PLANTING.

AN ACT relating to oyster lands and repealing chapters XXIV (24) and XXV (25) of the Laws of 1895, and declaring that this act shall take effect immediately.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That chapters XXIV (24) and XXV (25) of the Laws of 1895, pages 36 to 41, are hereby repealed: *Provided*, That nothing herein shall be construed as affecting any rights acquired under said acts repealed, or either thereof, or the state's reversionary interests therein: *And provided further*, That the commissioner of public lands may complete any applications properly filed in his office under the provisions of said chapter XXIV (24) prior to the date upon which this act takes effect.

mediately.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
