

## CHAPTER 294.

## PARK LANDS IN PASCO.

AN ACT relating to certain park lands in the city of Pasco; and authorizing the city to lease, sell, or otherwise dispose of such lands.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Pasco, upon finding that the property is not required for park purposes, shall have power to lease, sell, or otherwise dispose to the best and highest bidder after advertising for bids in not less than three editions of the official newspaper, the following described property located in Franklin county, state of Washington:

Authority of city council of Pasco to dispose of property after finding the same is not required for park purposes.

Those portions of the west half of the west half of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2}W\frac{1}{2}SW\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Thirty (30), Township Nine (9) North, Range Thirty (30) East, W. M., lying north of a line drawn parallel with and distant 700 feet northerly from the south line of the southeast quarter ( $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said section thirty (30), EXCEPT those portions thereof of Lucas Street, Hopkins Street, Olive Street, Mound Street and Grace Street, which were dedicated to the public by Order of the Board of County Commissioners of Franklin County, Washington [as] of July 3, 1922, and which order was recorded July 5, 1922 as auditor's file No. 50692 in Volume 42 of Deeds at page 586, records of Franklin County, Washington.
