[S. B. 2.]

APPROPRIATIONS—LEGISLATORS' EXPENSES.

AN ACT relating to legislators' expenses, providing for payments to legislators for lodging and expenses, making an appropriation and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation for expenses of members of extraordinary session.

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated out of the general fund of the state of Washington the sum of twenty-one thousand seven hundred fifty dollars for the actual and necessary expenses of the members of the first extraordinary session of the thirty-fourth legislature of the state of Washington. From the amount appropriated each member shall be paid a sum not to exceed fifteen dollars per day in lieu of subsistence and lodging while in attendance at the legislature.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate support of the state government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately.
