

CHAPTER 96

[Senate Bill No. 2847]

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL--LICENSED PREMISES--18
YEAR OLD PROFESSIONAL MUSICIANS--
EMPLOYMENT PERMITTED

AN ACT Relating to alcoholic beverage control; and adding a new section to chapter 62, Laws of 1933 ex. sess. and to chapter 66.44 RCW; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. There is added to chapter 62, Laws of 1933 ex. sess. and to chapter 66.44 RCW a new section to read as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of RCW 26.28.080 as now or hereafter amended, it is lawful for professional musicians, eighteen years of age and older, to enter and to remain in any premises licensed under the provisions of Title 66 RCW, but only during and in the course of their employment as musicians.

This section shall not be construed as permitting the sale or distribution of any alcoholic beverages to any person under the age of nineteen years.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. This 1973 act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.

CHAPTER 97

SOUTHWEST WASHINGTON FAIR--

AN ACT Relating to the southwest Washington fair and property utilized therefor; amending sections 36.90.010, 36.90.020, 36.90.030, 36.90.040 and 36.90.050, chapter 4, Laws of 1963 and RCW 36.90.010, 36.90.020, 36.90.030, 36.90.040 and 36.90.050; repealing section 36.90.060, chapter 4, Laws of 1963 and RCW 36.90.060; and creating new sections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Section 1. Section 36.90.010, chapter 4, Laws of 1963 and RCW 36.90.010 are each amended to read as follows:
