• Last day to read in committee reports from originating house except reports from the Senate Ways and Means Committee and House Fiscal Committees

• Last day for original house committee reports from the Senate Ways and Means Committee and House Fiscal Committees

• Last day to consider bills from originating house (5 p.m.)

• Last day to read in committee reports from opposite house except reports from the Senate Ways and Means Committee and House Fiscal Committees

• Last day for opposite houses committee reports from the Senate Ways and Means Committee and House Fiscal Committees

• Last day to consider opposite house bills (5 p.m.) (except initiatives to the legislature, messages pertaining to amendments, differences between the houses, conference reports, and matters incident to the interim and to closing the business of the 1991 legislature)

• Last day of regular session—constitutionally

**Budgets, matters necessary to implement the budgets, and initiatives to the legislature are exempt from cutoffs until the 96th Day. After the 96th Day, only initiatives, messages pertaining to amendments, differences between the houses, conference reports, and matters relating to the interim or closing the session may be considered.**
