APPROPRIATION FOR WENATCHEE BRIDGE BONDS.

AN ACT making an appropriation from the public highway fund for the redemption of the Wenatchee bridge bonds and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) be and the same is hereby appropriated from the public highway fund for the redemption of the Wenatchee bridge bonds. Appropriation, \$50,000.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety and support of the existing institutions of the state and shall take effect immediately. Emergency.

Approved by the Governor January 30, 1917.

CHAPTER 6.

CHANGING NAME OF CITY OF NORTH YAKIMA.

AN ACT changing the name of the city of North Yakima to Yakima.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the name of North Yakima, a city located in Yakima county, State of Washington, be and the same is hereby changed to Yakima. Name changed to Yakima.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and shall be in full force and effect from and after January 1, 1918. Time of taking effect.

Passed the Senate January 12, 1917.

Passed the House January 25, 1917.

Approved by the Governor January 30, 1917.
