STATE LANDS—EASEMENT GRANT.

AN ACT relating to state lands and providing for easements thereon.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The Commissioner of Public Lands, with the consent of the Director of the Department of Public Institutions, is hereby authorized to grant an easement for ingress and egress across state lands to the owners of that portion of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section one, township nineteen, north, range six east of the Willamette Meridian, all situated in Pierce County.
