STATE LANDS—EXCHANGE IN OLYMPIC
NATIONAL PARK.

AN ACT relating to exchange of state and federal lands.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of
Washington:*

SECTION 1. The state land board and the commissioner of public lands are authorized by this act to exchange the west half of section 36, township 30 north, range 9 west, W.M., containing approximately three hundred twenty acres situated within the boundaries of Olympic National Park and owned by the state of Washington, for lots 1, 2, 3, 4 of section 1; lots 1, 2, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, N $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 2; N $\frac{1}{2}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 10; NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 12; S $\frac{1}{2}$ S $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 20; S $\frac{1}{2}$ of section 21, township 24 north, range 11 west, W.M., containing approximately one thousand two hundred thirty eight and seventy-two one hundredths acres situated within Queets corridor and other lands owned by the United States government.

Authorization to exchange state land within Olympic National Park.

SEC. 2. Section 1 of this act is declared to be a temporary section which need not be codified in RCW and which section shall expire when the exchange of lands authorized thereby shall have been consummated: *Provided*, That the repeal of section 1 by expiration of the period for which it is enacted shall not be construed as affecting any existing right created by this act.

Section 1 declared temporary section.

Repeal of section 1.

SEC. 3. The state land board and the commissioner of public lands are authorized to take such steps and perform such acts as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this act and to consummate the exchange of lands provided for herein.
