LINCOLN'S BIRTHDAY.

An Act declaring the anniversary of the birth of Abraham Lincoln a legal holiday.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the twelfth day of February of each year, the same being the anniversary of the birth of Abraham Lincoln, be and it is hereby declared to be a legal holiday in the State of Washington.

Passed the senate January 30, 1895. Passed the house February 8, 1895. Approved February 12, 1895.

CHAPTER IV.

FISH HATCHERIES.

An Act to establish and maintain state fish hatcheries, making an appropriation therefor, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. The governor, state treasurer and fish commissioner are hereby created a board of fish commissioners ex officio.

Fish hatcheries. SEC. 2. It shall be the duty of the fish commission created by the provisions of section one (1) of this act to procure a suitable site or suitable sites for one or more state fish hatcheries, to provide for the creation of such state fish hatchery or hatcheries, and to supervise the management and control of the same.

Hatcheries, where located. SEC. 3. The site for the first state fish hatchery shall be upon the banks of the Columbia river or one of its tributaries, and shall be selected and obtained as soon as pos-
