CHAPTER CLIV. [H. B. No. 228.]

FOR THE PROTECTION OF THE AMERICAN FLAG. AN ACT for the protection of the American flag and coat of arms of the United States.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the national flag or the coat of arms of the United States or any imitation or representation Not to be attached to or imprinted or repreimprinted on goods, etc. sented upon any goods, wares, or merchandise, or any advertisement of the same; and no goods, wares, or merchandise, or any advertisement of the same, shall be attached to the national flag or the coat of arms of the United States, and no such advertisement shall be imprinted thereon. Any violation of this act shall be punishable, on conviction in any court of competent Penalty. jurisdiction in the State of Washington, by a fine of not more than five hundred dollars.

Passed the House March 2, 1901. Passed the Senate March 13, 1901. Approved by the Governor March 18, 1901.

CHAPTER CLV. [S. B. No. 137.]

APPROPRIATION FOR PAYMENT OF BOUNTIES.

AN ACT making an appropriation for the payment of bounties under the provisions of an act approved February 21, 1899, entitled "An act granting a bounty for the encouragement of the production and manufacture of sugar in the State of Washington."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That there is hereby appropriated from any moneys in the treasury of the State of Washing--21 Appropriation. ton, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of forty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to pay any claim or claims for bounty for the production and manufacture of sugar in the State of Washington, earned or to be earned under the provisions of an act approved February 21, 1899, entitled "An act granting a bounty for the encouragement of the production and manufacture of sugar in the State of Disbursement. Washington." Said appropriation shall be disbursed under and subject to the provisions and limitations of said act of February 21, 1899.

CHAPTER CLVI. [S. B. No. 205.] °

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION FOR STATE BOARD OF HEALTH.

AN ACT making an appropriation for the State Board of Health for the remainder of the fiscal year ending March 31st, 1901.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars be appropriated out of the general funds of the state, not otherwise appropriated, for the expenses of the State Board of Health for the remainder of the fiscal year ending March 31, 1901.

Passed the Senate February 25, 1901. Passed the House March 13, 1901. Approved by the Governor March 18, 1901.
