AMENDING ACT RELATIVE TO DRAINAGE DISTRICTS.

AN ACT to amend section 3753 of Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington, relating to drainage districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington: SECTION 1. That section 3753 of Ballinger's Annotated Sec. 3753 Ballinger's Code. Codes and Statutes of Washington be hereby amended to read as follows: Section 3753. The whole or any portion of any natural water course, the whole or any portion of which lies within any district established under this chapter, or the whole or any portion of any ditch or drainage system already constructed or partially constructed prior to the passage of this chapter, may be improved and completed as a system under the provisions of this chapter. Provided. That vested rights in any such water course acquired by appropriation of the water thereof for irrigation, mining or manufacturing purposes under existing law, shall not be disturbed.
