

## CHAPTER 18.

## AMENDING ACT CREATING BUREAU OF INSPECTION.

AN ACT to amend section 9 of an act entitled "An act to create a bureau of inspection and supervision of public offices, and to establish a uniform system of public accounting, auditing and reporting under the administration of the State Auditor," approved March 10, 1909; and declaring an emergency.

SECTION 1. That section 9 of an act entitled "An act to create a bureau of inspection and supervision of public offices, and to establish a uniform system of public accounting, auditing and reporting under the administration of the State Auditor," approved March 10, 1909, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 9. Each and every claim for services performed, supplies furnished or claims of any nature for which compensation is asked, shall be sworn to before an officer authorized to administer oaths; that all public officers are required to take such affidavits without charge: *Provided*, That this section shall not apply to officers or employes drawing annual or monthly salaries, nor to the salaries of legislators, legislative employes, nor to the fees of jurors and witnesses: *And provided further*, That pay rolls for daily wages may be sworn to by the superintendent, foreman or person in charge of the work.
