## ELECTIVE PUBLIC OFFICERS.

AN ACT relating to the qualifications of public officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Must be citizens and electors. Section 1. That no person shall be competent to qualify for or hold any elective public office within the State of Washington, or any county, district, precinct, school district, municipal corporation or other district or political subdivision, unless he be a citizen of the United States and State of Washington and an elector of such county, district, precinct, school district, municipality or other district or political subdivision.

Passed the House February 27, 1919. Passed the Senate March 10, 1919. Approved by the Governor March 17, 1919.

## CHAPTER 140.

## DIVISION OF COUNTY INTO ROAD DISTRICTS.

An Act relating to the formation of road districts, validating certain tax levies made, providing for their collection and amending Section 5576 of Remington & Ballinger's Annotated Codes and Statutes of Washington.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. That section 5576 of Remington & Ballinger's Code be amended to read as follows:

Section 5576. The board of county commissioners shall, as often as they deem it necessary,
