COUNTY FAIRS.

AN ACT relating to county fairs and amending Section 2753 of Remington's Compiled Statutes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That Section 2753 of Remington's Compiled Statutes be amended to read as follows:

Section 2753. Appropriations in any one year by boards of county commissioners for the purpose of acquisition of property and the maintenance of such fairs shall be limited according to the following schedule:

Counties of more than 100,000.....	\$10,000.00
Counties of between 100,000 and 50,000.....	7,500.00
Counties of between 40,000 and 25,000.....	5,000.00
Counties under 25,000.....	2,500.00

SEC. 2. Add a new section to be numbered 2753 1/2, to read as follows:

Section 2753 1/2. The board of county commissioners of any county containing a population of not more than 35,000, is hereby authorized to expend a sum not exceeding \$10,000.00 to be used only for the purpose of acquiring necessary grounds for said county fair and for the construction of buildings thereon and for the improvement of the same.
