## CHAPTER 185.

## [S. S. B. 92.]

## STUDENT FEES, STATE COLLEGE OF WASHINGTON.

AN AGT relating to a system of student fees in the state college of Washington and providing for the collection and disposition of the same, and amending section 2 of chapter 164 of the Laws of 1921, and repealing section 1 of chapter 9, of the Laws of the Extraordinary Session of 1909.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. That section 2 of chapter 164 of the Laws of 1921 be amended to read as follows:

Section 2. The tuition fees collected under section 1 of this act shall be deposited with the state treasurer in the State College of Washington Building Fund, and expended by the board of regents for either buildings or equipment or maintenance on the campus of the State College of Washington or at any of the experimental stations under the control of the board of regents as may be deemed most advisable for the best interests of the institution. Expenditures so made shall be accounted for in accordance with existing law, and shall not be expended until appropriated by the legislature.

SEC. 2. That section 1 of chapter 9 of the Laws of the Extraordinary Session of 1909 be and the same is hereby repealed.
