SALE OF CERTAIN PUBLIC LAND FOR CEMETERY PURPOSES.

AN Act relating to the sale of a tract of state land for cemetery purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The commissioner of public lands is hereby authorized and directed to offer for sale and sell at public auction in the manner provided by law, after appraisal by the board of state land commissioners, the following described land, to-wit:

That part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 6, township 33 north, range 24 east, W. M., described as follows:

Descriptions.

Beginning at the northwest corner of said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and running thence east 4.00 chains, south 5.00 chains, west 4.00 chains and north 5.00 chains to said point of beginning, containing an area of 2.00 acres, the said land now being used for cemetery purposes.
