That the total number of persons voting at such special election shall constitute forty per cent of the voters in said taxing district who voted for the office of governor at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

CHAPTER 3.

LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

An Act appropriating the sum of one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses of the Twenty-sixth Legislature and for expenses incurred in completing the work of the Twenty-fifth Legislature, and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby Appropriaappropriated out of the general fund, the sum of one hundred and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the purposes of paying the expenses of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Washington, convening January 9, 1939, together with the expenses incurred by the Legislature in completing the work of the Twenty-fifth Legislature and the expenses incurred in advance of the Twenty-sixth Legislature.

Effective immediately.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the support of the state government and shall take effect immediately.

CHAPTER 4.

LEGISLATIVE PRINTING.

An Acr appropriating the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary for the printing of the Twenty-sixth Legislature and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation. Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the general fund the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to pay for such printing as may be ordered by the Twenty-sixth Session of the Legislature, convened January 9, 1939, or either branch thereof.

Effective immediately.

Sec. 2. This act is necessary for the support of the state government and shall take effect immediately.
