FIRE PROTECTION OF STATE PROPERTY.

An Act authorizing the Director of Finance, Budget and Business to make payments to fire protection districts for fire protection of state owned property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

State to contribute to fire protection district. Section 1. Wherever a fire protection district has been organized which includes within its area, or is adjacent to, state owned property, the Director of Finance, Budget and Business is authorized to arrange for and to make contributions to such district, by payment to the County Treasurer, of the county in which the district is located, such sum or sums as in his discretion may be equitable for the fire protection received by the State but in no event to exceed the amount such district would receive in revenue should such state property be on the tax rolls of such district.
