ADDITIONAL COMPENSATION TO COUNTY
COMMISSIONER AS ROAD OVERSEER.

AN ACT relating to the compensation of county commissioners,
and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of
Washington:*

SECTION 1. Section 1, chapter 274, Laws of 1927
(sec. 4053-1, Rem. Rev. Stat.) is amended to read as
follows:

Section 1. It shall be the duty of each member
of the board of county commissioners, in counties
of the sixth, seventh, eighth and ninth classes, in
addition to his duties as a member of the board
of county commissioners and as ex-officio road com-
missioner of the several road districts in his commis-
sioner's district, to oversee the construction and
maintenance of all county and district roads and
bridges in his commissioner's district, and for time
actually spent in the performance of such duties as
overseer, he shall be entitled to compensation at the
rate of ten dollars (\$10) per diem: *Provided*, That
as such compensation for overseeing the construc-
tion and maintenance of roads and bridges in his
commissioner's district he shall not receive more
than one thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) per
annum. All claims for such compensation shall be
approved by a majority of the board of county com-
missioners and the superior judge, as required by
law.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the immediate
support of the state government and its existing pub-
lic institutions, and shall take effect immediately.
