PROHIBITING SALE OF CERTAIN STATE LANDS.

AN ACT relating to the reservation of certain state lands in Cowlitz County from sale or lease, and amending chapter 157, Laws of 1915.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Amendment. SECTION 1. Chapter 157, Laws of 1915 (uncodified), is amended to read as follows:

Lands reserved from sale.

That all of the shore lands, beds and waters of Lake Merrill, in sections 8, 9, 16, 17 and 21, in township seven, north of range four east of the Wilamette Meridian, in Cowlitz County; and all of the lands in said section 16, are hereby reserved from sale and the same shall not be sold.

CHAPTER 135.

ADMISSION INTO STATE PENAL INSTITUTIONS OF PRISONERS OF THE UNITED STATES AND OF OTHER STATES.

AN ACT relating to the admission into Washington penal institutions of persons convicted of crime and sentenced to prison by the authority of the United States or of any state or territory of the United states, and providing for the terms under which such custodial services are to be rendered.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Authorizing confinement of persons sentenced by other courts.

SECTION 1. All persons sentenced to prison by the authority of the United States or of any state or territory of the United States may be received by the department of public institutions and im-
