INDIGENT PERSON—COUNTY TO DISPOSE
OF REMAINS.

AN ACT providing for the disposition of the remains of certain indigent persons and repealing section 36.39.020, R.C.W.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. The board of county commissioners of any county shall provide for the disposition of the remains of any indigent person not a recipient of public assistance who dies within the county and whose body is unclaimed by relatives or friends. Indigents;

SEC. 2. Section 36.39.020, R.C.W., derived from section 2701 of the Code of 1881 is hereby repealed. } Vetoed.
