WASHINGTON STATE BAR ASSOCIATION— MEMBERSHIP FEES.

An Act relating to membership fees of members of the Washington State Bar Association.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 2.48.130, RCW, as derived Amendment. from section 9, chapter 94, Laws of 1933, is amended to read as follows:

The annual membership fees for active members Membership shall be the sum of fifteen dollars payable on or before February 1st of each year: *Provided*, That for all those who have been active members for less than five years in this state or elsewhere, the annual membership fee shall be ten dollars.
