STATE GOVERNMENT—SUBSISTENCE FOR OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES.

AN ACT increasing the subsistence allowance for state officers and employees, and amending section 43.03.050, RCW.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 43.03.050, RCW, as derived Amendment. from section 1, chapter 86, Laws of 1943, as last amended by section 1, chapter 17, Laws of 1949, is amended to read as follows:

The heads of all state departments may prescribe Per diem per diem rates of allowance, not exceeding nine dollars in lieu of subsistence and lodging to elective and appointive officials and state employees while engaged on official business away from their designated posts of duty, but within the state of Washington or an adjoining state, and not exceeding twelve dollars per day while engaged on official business elsewhere.
