INJURIES CAUSED BY INTOXICATED PERSONS.

AN ACT relating to civil procedure; and repealing section 1, chapter 62, Laws of 1905 and RCW 4.24.100.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Repeal.

SECTION 1. Section 1, chapter 62, Laws of 1905 and RCW 4.24.100 are each repealed.
