CHAPTER 77.

[House Bill No. 203.]

STATE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES—PER DIEM.

An Act relating to state government; increasing per diem allowances; and amending section 43.03.050, chapter 8, Laws of 1965 (Senate Bill No. 4) and RCW 43.03.050.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. Section 43.03.050, chapter 8, Laws of RCW 43.03.050 1965 (Senate Bill No. 4) and RCW 43.03.050 are each amended to read as follows:

The heads of all state departments may pre- State officers, scribe per diem rates of allowance, not exceeding subsistence fifteen dollars in lieu of subsistence and lodging to elective and appointive officials and state employees while engaged on official business away from their designated posts of duty, but within the state of Washington, and not exceeding twentyfive dollars per day while engaged on official business elsewhere.
