## MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATORS—FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY.

AN ACT relating to financial responsibility of motor vehicle operators and owners; requiring department to reevaluate security upon correction of erroneous information; and amending section 20, chapter 169, Laws of 1963 as amended by section 4, chapter 124, Laws of 1965 and RCW 46.29.200.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. Section 20, chapter 169, Laws of 1963 RCW 46.29.200 as amended by section 4, chapter 124, Laws of 1965 and RCW 46.29.200 are each amended to read as follows:

amended.

Whenever the department has taken any action Motor vehicles. Financial responsibility. Correction of action by reason of having received erroneous information, action by department. then upon receiving correct information within three years after the date of an accident the department shall take appropriate action to carry out the purposes and effect of this chapter. The foregoing, however, shall not be deemed to require the department to reevaluate the amount of any deposit required under this chapter.
