Sec. 3. Section 14, chapter 236, Laws of 1967, and RCW 67.28-.210 are each amended to read as follows:

All taxes levied and collected under RCW 67.28.180 shall be credited to a special fund in the treasury of the county <u>or city</u> imposing such tax. Such taxes shall be levied only for the purpose of paying all or any part of the cost of acquisition, construction, or operating of stadium facilities or to pay or secure the payment of all or any portion of general obligation bonds or revenue bonds issued for such purpose or purposes under this chapter, and until withdrawn for use, the moneys accumulated in such fund or funds may be invested in interest bearing securities by the county <u>or city</u> treasurer in any manner authorized by law.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 4. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, the support of the state government and its existing public institutions and shall take effect immediately.

> CHAPTER 90 [Substitute House Bill No. 169] DOMESTIC ANIMALS--INJURING OR KILLING--PENALTY

AN ACT Relating to agriculture; adding a new section to Title 9 RCW; and prescribing penalties.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 1. There is added to Title 9 RCW a new section to read as follows:

Any person who injures or kills by shooting or poisoning any horse, mule, cattle, sheep, swine, or goat without the permission of the owner thereof and who does not commit grand larceny as defined by RCW 9.54.090 shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor.
