## Productivity Drives Growth

Declining WA Apple Acreage: 172,000 acres in 1993
167,489 acres in 2011
2.6\% decline in acreage.


Growth of Apple Production in the same period:
83,088,000 boxes in 1993
128,294,000 boxes in 2012
An increase of 54.4\%.

## Risk and Capital

- A WSU study estimated the cost per acre of establishing a Gala orchard at $\$ 32,281$ for the first four years (before full production) and $\$ 11,923$ per acre thereafter.
- A grower must commit to and carry these costs for four years without knowing what market conditions will be when the orchard becomes fully productive.
