I knew after 5 years of being a direct care staff that i did not want to reach retirement broken from the years of this type of work. It is proven that reflexes, alertness, speed, sight, memory all decrease as we age.

We provide services to dually diagnosed people who can have very aggressive behaviour ,and the ability to think , move , and react quickly is essential for everyone's safety.
