Dear Chair Manweller and Vice-Chair Conway, and members of the SCPP,

SHB 1560 (link below) was introduced during the 2018 Session. This bill would have changed the present retirement default plan from Plan 3 to Plan 2.

A public hearing in the House was held. The House then passed the bill 66-29-3. It was then sent to the Senate where it died. In speaking to Senator Rolfes, she made it clear she was uncomfortable holding a hearing on a bill that did originate from a SCPP agency request.

On behalf of the Washington State School Retirees' Association, I would like to formally and respectfully request that this option/bill be put on a future SCPP agenda for discussion, analysis, and action by the SCPP.

The fiscal note prepared by the State Actuary may need to be updated, but the last analysis showed <u>savings</u> to the state general fund ranging from \$43 to \$143 over a 25-year period.
