Dear Senate Committee on Pension Policy:

I am writing as a retiree in PERS to advocate for the reinstatement of a permanent cost-of-living-adjustment (COLA) for all Plan 1 retirees. As you know, the legislature eliminated a permanent COLA for Plan 1 retirees in 2012 when WA State was experiencing budget problems.

The lack of a yearly COLA is a real hardship on retirees. Can you imagine how you would manage your expenses if you didn't have a wage increase in 10 years? The legislature has passed a few yearly COLA increases, but inflation in the last 10 years has greatly surpassed the few one-time COLAs. In the Seattle-Tacoma-Bremerton area the Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased 36% from August 2012 to August 2022. It also increased 36% in the Western Region of the US for the same time period.

I urge you to right this wrong. The retirees in Plan 1 served our state faithfully for years and deserve a retirement that allows them to live without fear of falling into poverty. Please reinstatement a permanent COLA for Plan 1 retirees.
