Dear Chair Conway:

I am writing to ask you and the members of the Select Committee on Pensions Policy (SCC) to take immediate action to restore a permanent cost of living adjustment (COLA) to Plan 1 retirees. As you know, with inflation and no COLA it has been very tough these last many years. Only a permanent COLA guarantees financial, food and housing security in retirement.

The one-time COLA secured in the last legislative session for Plan 1 retirees like me is deeply appreciated, and provided temporary relief. However this was a short term fix that does not address the problem of long standing inequity that plagues Plan 1 retirees. Year after year the states Plan 1 retirees like me continue to lose purchasing power.

With the pay down of the unfunded liability in the Plan 1 pension plan on the horizon, the Retired Public Employees Council (RPEC) respectfully request that you work this legislative session to codify, in law, a trigger point by which the state will fund a permanent COLA for Plan 1 retirees.

Thank you in advance for considering this request by RPEC. We are counting on you to lead the path forward to legislation to finally fix this problem.
