



# Memorandum

**Re:** 2008 Interim Project – Regional delivery of educational programs, training, & services through Educational Service Districts

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**Project Description:** The committee staff will review and summarize the current programs, training, and services offered regionally through the Educational Service Districts (ESDs) and create a list of services common to all ESDs and a list of services that are unique to each of the ESDs and the costs of those services. Additionally, the committee staff will summarize information on the status of the efforts in response to the 2006 performance audit recommendations to further develop the ESDs in an effective statewide system of regional support.

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**History:** Before ESDs were created, there were 39 county superintendent offices and county school boards. These county administrations were responsible to oversee the establishment and operation of local school districts and to collect fiscal and enrollment information for the Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI).<sup>1</sup>

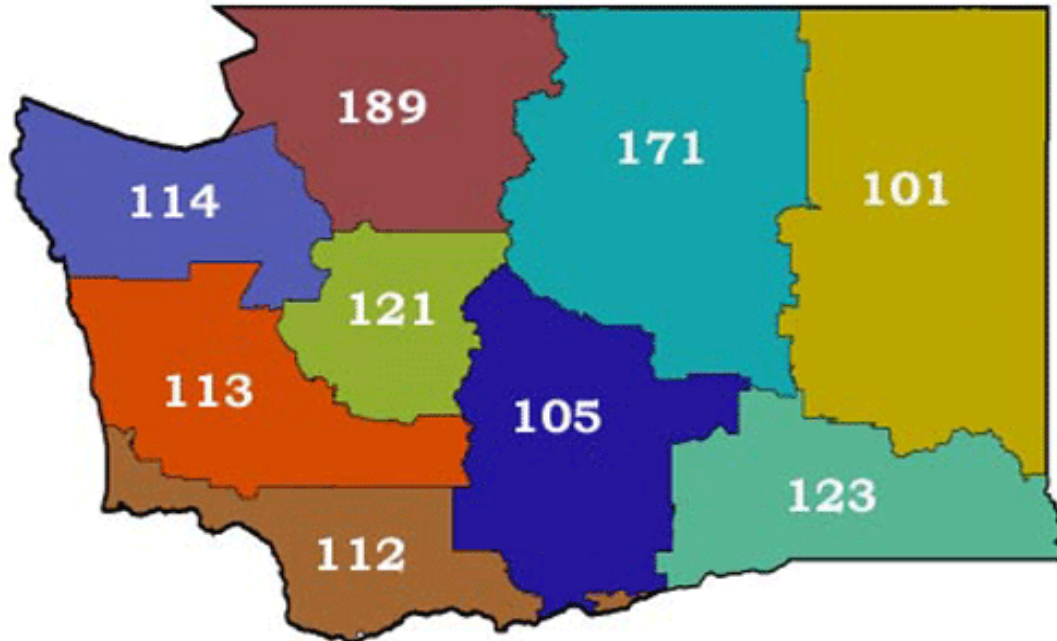
In 1969, the state legislature reorganized the 39 county offices into regional bodies called Intermediate School Districts (ISDs) and gave the State Board of Education (SBE) the responsibility of creating the number and boundaries of these districts. The legislative intent language provided that the ISDs would provide equal educational opportunities to the students in the state, however, the duties of the ISDs were still regulatory and administrative.<sup>2</sup> In 1971, the role of the ISDs was changed to function as a regional educational service agency. In this new role the ISDs were to provide cooperative and informational services to local school districts; to assist the OSPI and the SBE in the performance of their duties; and to provide students with equal educational opportunities.<sup>3</sup>

In 1975, the legislature changed the name of the ISDs to ESDs.<sup>4</sup> In 1977, the legislature defined in statute the core services to be provided by ESDs so that biennial budget requests could be based on measurable goals and needs. In addition to the services already required to be provided by the ESDs, the legislature added administration and facilities assistance, including fiscal, grant management services; special education and transportation services; personnel services; learning resource services; cooperative curriculum services; and services to address the needs of the local school districts.<sup>5</sup>

Increasingly, the legislature has designated the ESDs to provide technical support or other services, including professional development, in order to make the service

available to all school districts statewide.<sup>6</sup> However, there is no current statutory recognition of a system of ESDs in Washington state.

**Structure and Governance:** Forty-four states, including Washington, have a regional support infrastructure for schools and school districts. Each Washington ESD is governed by a seven- to nine-member board of directors. Board members are elected to 4-year terms by the local school board members. Each ESD's board of directors has final decision-making authority and hires the ESD superintendent. There are currently nine ESDs in Washington.

**ESD Services:** The basic core services of the ESDs are identified in statute.<sup>7</sup> Core services include, but are not be limited to, the following:

- Educational service district administration and facilities such as office space, maintenance and utilities;
- Cooperative administrative services such as assistance in carrying out procedures to abolish sex and race bias in school programs, fiscal services, grants management services, special education services and transportation services;
- Personnel services such as certification/registration services;
- Learning resource services such as audio visual aids;
- Cooperative curriculum services such as health promotion and health education services, in-service training, workshops and assessment;
- Professional development services identified by statute or the omnibus appropriations act; and
- Special needs of local education agencies.

Additionally, there is a set of services that are not statutorily defined as core services but are available in every ESD. These services include:

- Student assistance;
- Public transportation;
- Safe and drug-free schools;
- School improvement plans;
- District improvement plans;
- State reporting assistance;
- Teacher training and coaching;
- Leadership coaching;
- Technology and district technical support;
- Professional development support; and
- Educational technology centers.

Each ESD has developed additional programs to serve the unique needs of the schools within the ESD's region. Please consult Appendices A, B, and C for three lists of courses offered by each ESD – arranged by ESD, by subject and by type of course.

**Funding:** The ESDs have access to a combination of financial resources from state, federal, and local sources to provide services. The ESDs receive state funds for core services. These funds are appropriated by the Legislature, which assigns a weighting factor to core service costs, a geographical factor for larger ESDs, and a factor based on the number and size of local school districts within each ESD. In 2007-09 biennial operating budget, the ESDs received \$11.7 million, which included funding for the nurse corp and for regional professional development for mathematics and science teachers. Participation by school districts in ESD programs is voluntary. As a result, ESDs have customized and marketed their services to school districts, private schools, outside individuals and entities to generate additional revenues by charging fees-for-service, the sale of products, and other activities. ESDs have no taxing authority.

**2007 performance audit:** In 2007, the state auditor issued a performance audit report on the nine ESDs. The audit report found that the ESDs “have made significant progress. . .in trying to come together as a statewide ‘system’ of ESDs.” The report recommended that the ESDs “vigorously continue their efforts toward being recognized as a statewide “system” of ESDs.”

To implement this recommendation, the ESDs have used their existing Association of Educational Service Districts (AESD) to develop and approve a strategic plan that includes development of a statewide system of ESDs as a priority outcome. The ESD superintendents obtained a grant that enabled them to hire a consultant to facilitate systemic strategic planning related to the establishment of a formal statewide system of ESDs. Ongoing efforts will continue at regularly scheduled AESD Executive Committee and General Membership meetings.

The audit report also recommended that the ESDs consider taking the steps below to aid them in becoming more of a statewide system.<sup>8</sup> Information summarizing the actions taken or to be taken by the ESDs is provided after each recommendation:

- **Create a website with a statewide logo.**  
The ESDs are using their existing AESD website and have created a logo. <http://www.aesd-wa.org> The website provides the purpose for the association is to provide communication and coordination among ESD boards for educational advocacy; for fostering leadership and partnerships; and for collaboration within the educational community.
- **Develop a statewide video describing the services and value of the system.**  
Instead of a video the ESDs intend to include such information as part of the AESD website.
- **Create standing committees (legislative advocacy, public relations/marketing, etc.) for statewide work.**  
The ESDs currently have committees formed for network development, budget, defining assured services, and communications.

- ***Pursue development of statewide purchasing co-ops in food, office supplies, art supplies, sports/PE equipment and supplies, copiers, etc.***  
 Some technology hardware and software agreements in Washington are coordinated on a statewide basis either through the Department of Information Services (DIS) or the Washington State Information Processing Cooperative (WSIPC). These agencies solicit bids for technology items on behalf of all state agencies. Each ESD is a part owner and sits on the governing board of WSIPC and is thus responsible for providing purchasing agreements statewide for Microsoft, Citrix, and HP software. The nine ESDs also participate in a technology bid program administered by ESD 112 from which ESDs and school districts in eight states purchase. The newly created Washington Learning Sources (WLS) is a collaborative effort of the state's ESDs to provide significant cost savings to districts for educational hardware and software purchases. The WLS website is: <http://wlearningsource.org> Both ESDs and schools districts statewide also participate in the King County Directors' Association (KCDA), a statewide purchasing cooperative.
- ***Jointly enter into licensing agreements with private sector companies to provide statewide access for parents, students, and teachers to online resources.***  
 ESDs will seek funding to increase the availability of online instruction delivered via the K-20 network. The AESD will submit a funding proposal for legislative action. Additionally, the WLS, mentioned above, is a collaborative effort of the state's ESDs to provide significant cost savings to districts for educational hardware and software purchases. - ***Develop a financial formula for shared programs and services followed by development of a unified budget to support statewide staff, programs, and activities.***  
 The ESDs have completed a formula for fiscal technical assistance, and math and science regional coordinators, The ESDs intend to continue to develop financial formulas as shared programs and services emerge.
- ***Employ shared state or regional employees to carry out collaborative programs and services.***  
 Through Statewide Services the ESDs are carrying out collaborative program and services. Examples of such programs are in school construction and in special education.
- ***Explore creation of "centers of excellence" where one or two ESDs provide expertise and service to other ESD regions or throughout the state.***  
 The concept of coordinated delivery of services from one ESD into the regions of other ESDs is experiencing ongoing expansion. However, the ESDs choose to not use the term "Centers for Excellence" because they find the term disheartening as it implies the ESD receiving the service possesses less than excellence.

- **Create a system-wide annual report.**  
Currently the ESDs publish a bi-annual *AESD Accountability Report*. The ESDs intend to create a system-wide report as they develop more of a system.
- **Develop a system-wide strategic plan.**  
Each of the nine ESDs has various types of strategic planning processes in place. Additionally, the AESD has developed and approved a strategic plan that includes development of a statewide system of ESDs as a priority outcome.
- **Pursue additional partnership with state education associations.**  
The Washington State Education Coordinating Council (WSECC) has been created. The WSECC is an OSPI/ESD partnership that includes additional partners from the major education associations, teacher education programs around the state, and others. The group is currently working on developing long-range plans for implementing a comprehensive and coordinated state system for improving student achievement in math and science.
- **Standardize and implement a formal communication and joint planning process with OSPI.**  
The ESDs have approached the new Superintendent of Public Instruction and are exploring possibilities, including being a member of the Superintendent's cabinet.
- **Clarify roles and responsibilities between OSPI and ESDs**  
See the previous bullet.
- **Each ESD should place policies, procedures, handbooks, minutes, directories, guidelines, etc. on its website for easy public access – and link its site to the statewide website that is to be developed.**  
Each individual ESD maintains a website where most post the staff directories and include information about the board meetings but each ESD determines whether their policies, procedures, etc. are posted electronically. The AESD website had a link to each ESD website.
- **In collaboration with OSPI, develop a yearly customer satisfaction survey.**  
Currently each ESD conducts their own service evaluation. The ESDs intend to review the current *AESD Strategic Plan* to consider the addition of objectives related to statewide coordination of regional client satisfaction surveys, needs assessments, and program evaluations. The ESDs are currently developing an on-line survey to determine school districts' technology needs and how the ESDs might be able to address those needs.
