<b>Agency</b>	The Recreation and Conservation Office (RCO) administers grants to state agencies, local governments, nonprofits, and other entities
<b>Year Established</b>	1997
<b>Relevant Statute</b>	RCW 43.99N.060
<b>Program Goal</b>	To provide funding for acquiring, developing, equipping, maintaining, and improving youth or community athletic facilities.
<b>Agency Summary</b>	The Youth Athletic Facilities program provides grants to state and federal agencies, local governments, tribes, and other entities for projects that involve acquiring, developing, equipping, maintaining, and improving youth or community athletic facilities. Funds are divided equally between the development of new athletic facilities, the improvement of existing athletic facilities, and the maintenance of existing athletic facilities.
