Re: JLARC Preliminary report on 2021 Tax Preference Performance Reviews

Mr. Konopaski,

Thank you for the invitation to provide comments in response to the preliminary 2020 Tax Preference Performance Review, for the Washington Health Benefit Exchange (Exchange).

The exemption allows the state the Exchange to maximize its funding for operating the state's health insurance marketplace. Without the exemption, the Exchange would pay Business and Occupation taxes on appropriations from the legislature. We appreciate JLARC's thorough analysis, and the assessment provided by the Citizen Commission for Performance Measurement of Tax Preferences.

On behalf of the Exchange Board and Exchange leadership, we concur with JLARC staff and State Auditor's recommendations. We are hopeful JLARC members will endorse the recommendation that the Legislature eliminate the July 2023 expiration date, making the current preference permanent.

As noted in the JLARC findings, the preference allows the Exchange to maximize its state funding for operating a health insurance marketplace, which over one in four Washingtonians use to access health insurance coverage. The current preference reduces the Exchange's administrative costs by one million dollars a year, which enables us to provide more affordable coverage to Washington residents.
