## CHAPTER 1.

[S. B. 1.]

### LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the expenses of the fifteenth legislature and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

SECTION 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the general fund, the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, (\$100,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to be used for the purpose of paying the expenses of the fifteenth legislature of the State of Washington. Appropriation, \$100,000.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the support of state government and shall take effect immediately. Emergency.

Passed the Senate January 8, 1917.

Passed the House January 8, 1917.

Approved by the Governor January 9, 1917.

## CHAPTER 2.

[S. B. 2.]

### LEGISLATIVE PRINTING.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the printing of the fifteenth legislature, and declaring an emergency.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:*

SECTION 1. That there be, and there is hereby appropriated out of the general fund the sum of fifteen thousand Appropriation, \$15,000.
