CHAPTER I.

[S. B. No. 1.]

LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

AN ACT appropriating the sum of sixty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the expenses of the Seventh Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington :

SECTION 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the funds of the State of Washington, the sum of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the expenses of the Seventh Legislature of the State of Washington. Legislative expenses.

Passed the Senate January 15, 1901.

Passed the House January 17, 1901.

Approved by the Governor, January 18, 1901.

CHAPTER II.

[S. B. No. 17.]

APPROPRIATION FOR STATE NORMAL SCHOOL AT WHATCOM.

AN ACT making appropriation for the State Normal School at New Whatcom, Washington, for the balance of the fiscal year ending in 1901.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington :

SECTION 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of any money of the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of four thousand one hundred and fifty (\$4,150.00) dollars or so much thereof as may Appropriation New Whatcom Normal School' balance of fiscal term.
