FEES OF ELECTION OFFICERS.

AN ACT relating to elections; prescribing fees for election officers and amending section 29.45.120, R.C.W.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

SECTION 1. Section 29.45.120, R.C.W., as derived from section 1, chapter 186, Laws of 1945, is amended to read as follows: Amendment.

The fees of officers of election shall be as follows: Fees of election officers.

To the judges and clerks of an election not less than fifty cents, nor more than one dollar per hour for full time employed by each of them. To inspectors, the rate paid to judges and clerks plus an additional two hours' compensation. The person carrying the returns to the county auditor shall be entitled to ten cents per mile for each mile traveled.
