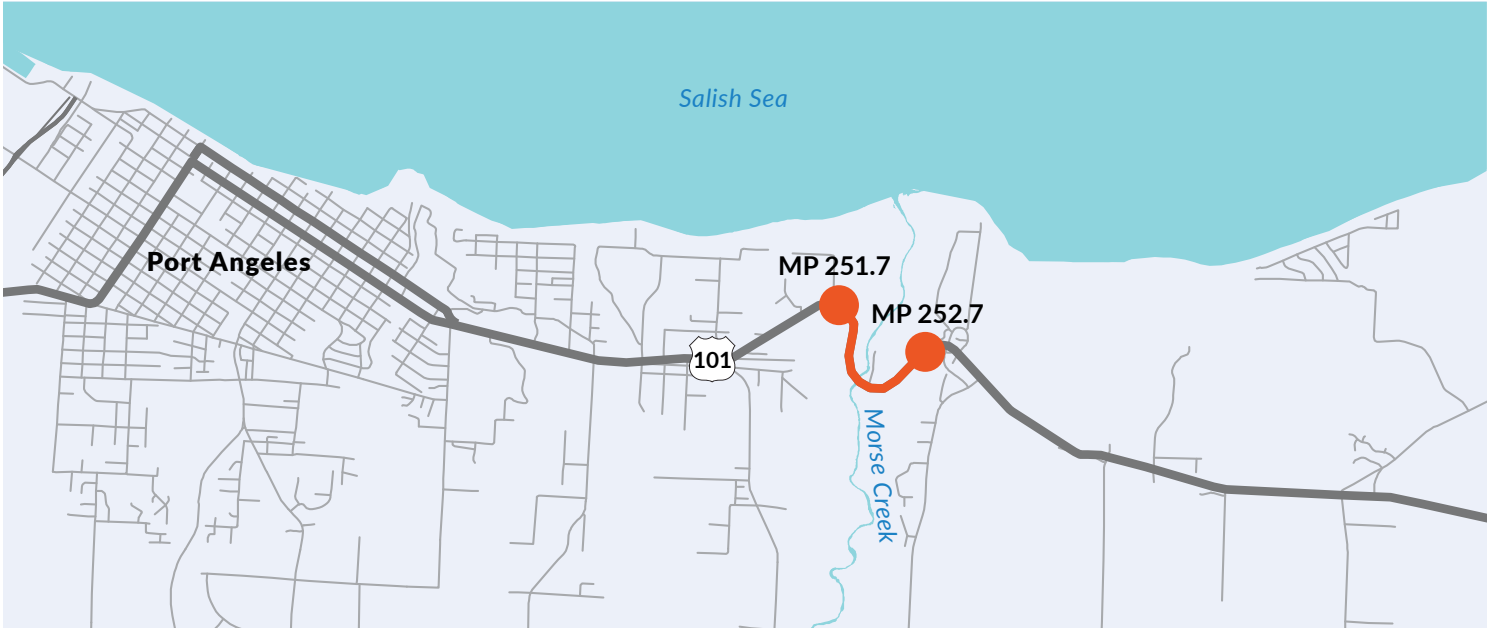


US 101 – MORSE CREEK VICINITY Safety Improvements



PROJECT OVERVIEW

Through a statewide analysis, two locations along US 101 near Port Angeles in Clallam County have been identified as needing improvements for travelers safety. WSDOT plans to construct a raised, center median and targeted speed limit reduction along a roughly one-mile stretch of US 101 to reduce the probability and severity of injury-collisions.

TIMELINE:

- Preliminary engineering: Fall 2019
- Advertise contract: Fall 2020
- Construction: Anticipated Spring 2021
- Complete: Anticipated Fall 2021

FUNDING:

\$3.6 million
(state and federal dollars)
