

CHAPTER 40.

LEGISLATIVE EXPENSES.

AN ACT appropriating the additional sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the expenses of the Twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Washington; and declaring an emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated out of the general fund the sum of thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000.00), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to be used for the purpose of paying the expenses of the twenty-fourth Legislature of the State of Washington convened January 14, 1935, and now in session; this sum being additional to any and all sums which may heretofore have been appropriated for such use and purpose.

Effective immediately.

SEC. 2. This act is necessary for the support of the state government and shall take effect immediately.
