

failure to pay the penalty and the department may not renew the person's driver's license until the penalty has been paid and the penalty provided in subsection (2) of this section has been paid.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. If any provision of this act or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the act or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

NEW SECTION. Sec. 8. This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, the support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and shall take effect immediately.

CHAPTER 20

[Senate Bill No. 3221]

UNIVERSITY OF WASHINGTON, SCHOOL OF DENTISTRY—RESIDENT TUITION AND FEES—REGIONALIZED PROGRAM

AN ACT Relating to the University of Washington; and amending section 1, chapter 105, Laws of 1975 1st ex. sess. and RCW 28B.15.225.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Washington:

Section 1. Section 1, chapter 105, Laws of 1975 1st ex. sess. and RCW 28B.15.225 are each amended to read as follows:

The board of regents of the University of Washington may exempt from payment of the nonresident portion of the legally-established student tuition and fees, any student admitted to the university's school of medicine pursuant to any contracts with the states of Alaska, Montana, or Idaho, or agencies thereof, providing for a program of regionalized medical education conducted by said school of medicine, or any student admitted to the university's school of dentistry pursuant to any contracts with the states of Utah, Idaho, or any other western state which does not have a school of dentistry, or agencies thereof, providing for a program of regionalized dental education conducted by said school of dentistry, which contracts provide that the proportional cost of such program and in excess of resident student tuition and fees will be reimbursed to the university by or on behalf of said states or agencies thereof.
