## Four follow up reviews cover multiple industries

#### **Aerospace**

(9 preferences)

Customized

**Workforce Training** 

(1 preference)

#### **Aluminum**

(8 preferences)

Precious Metals & Bullion

(2 preferences)

# Follow up reviews will focus on:

- 1. Legislative changes since last review.
- 2. Changes in preference use.
  - When appropriate, the racial and ethnic characteristics of beneficiaries and their employees.
- 3. Industry changes that may impact the inferred or stated objective.
- 4. Whether Legislative Auditor's prior recommendation is applicable to current circumstances.

### New review:

## PUT credit for home energy assistance

#### Who can claim it?

Electric and gas utilities

#### What can utilities claim?

50% of energy assistance through:

- Billing discounts to low-income customers.
- Contributions to organizations that provide energy assistance.



#### Home energy assistance PUT credit

### DOR allocates credits to utilities

- Credit capped at \$2.5 million per year.
- Allocation based on prior-year federal Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) grants to utilities.
- Utilities must apply for the credit.

Home energy assistance PUT credit

## Objective: Encourage additional home energy assistance from utilities

- Assistance is in addition to amounts offered through LIHEAP.
- Intent is to reduce the energy burden of low-income households.

#### **Energy burden**

The percentage of gross income a household spends on residential energy bills.

## Review will address

- 1. Amount of additional energy assistance utilities provide.
- 2. How the amount of additional assistance compares to the energy burden of low-income utility customers.
- 3. The racial and ethnic characteristics of the households receiving assistance.
- 4. The extent of overlap between this additional assistance and the distribution of LIHEAP funds.
